The biblical "road to Emmaus" today is a dirt path marked by the remnants of ancient Roman paving stones in this Palestinian village. El Qubeibeh, as Emmaus is today known, is nestled into a terraced West Bank hillside about eight miles northwest of the modern boundaries of Jerusalem. On the road to Emmaus Jesus appears to two disciples. This is the longest single post-resurrection narrative in the gospels. Believers are sustained by faith in Jesus that burns within their hearts.
